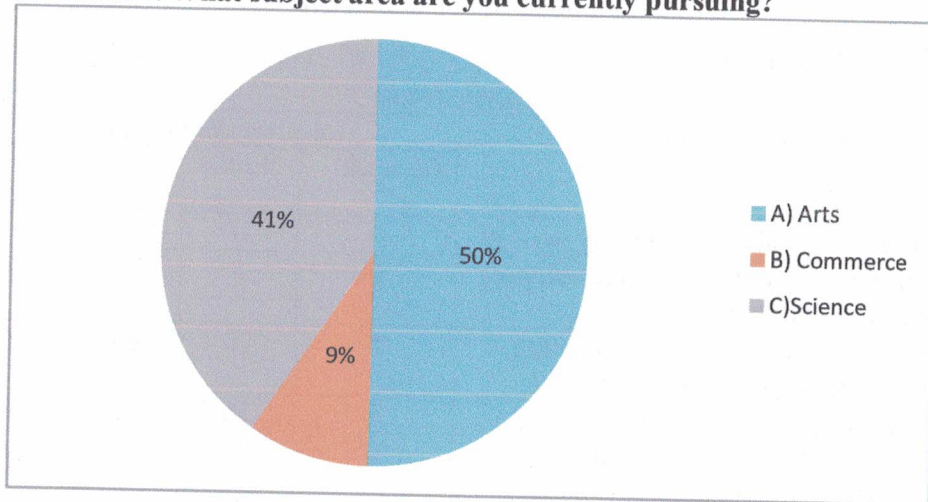

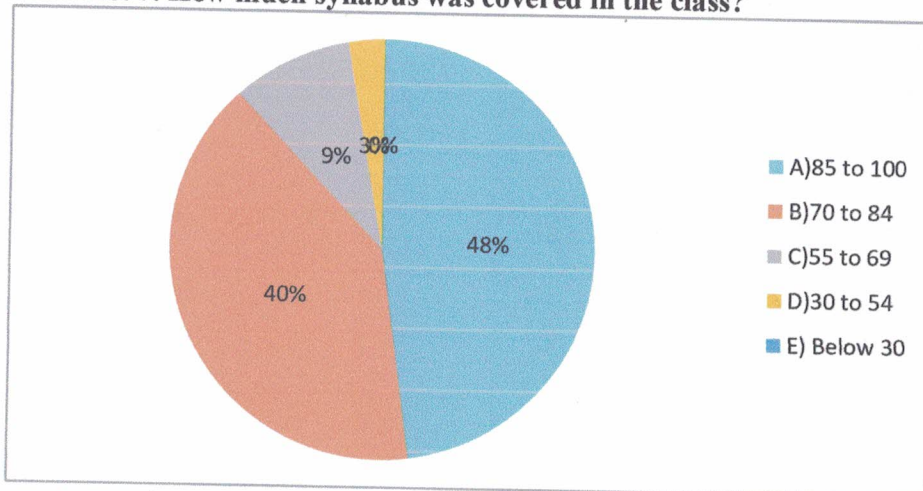

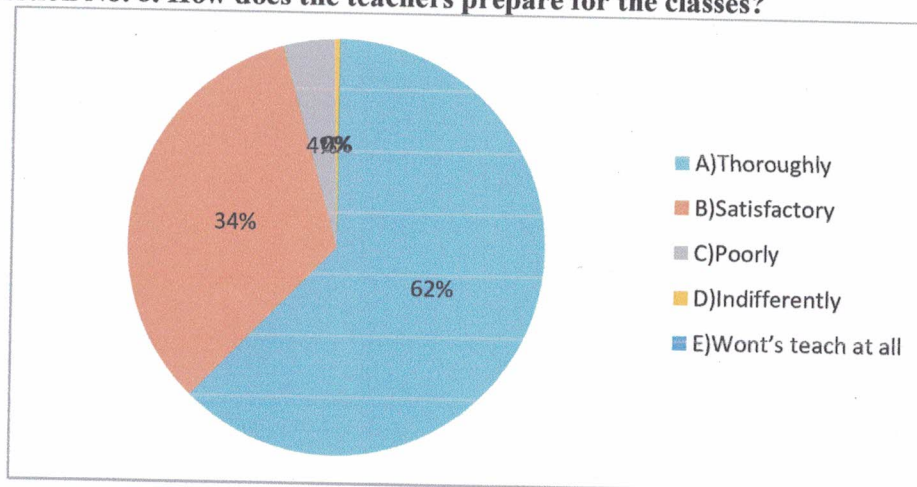
Question No. 6. What subject area are you currently pursuing?



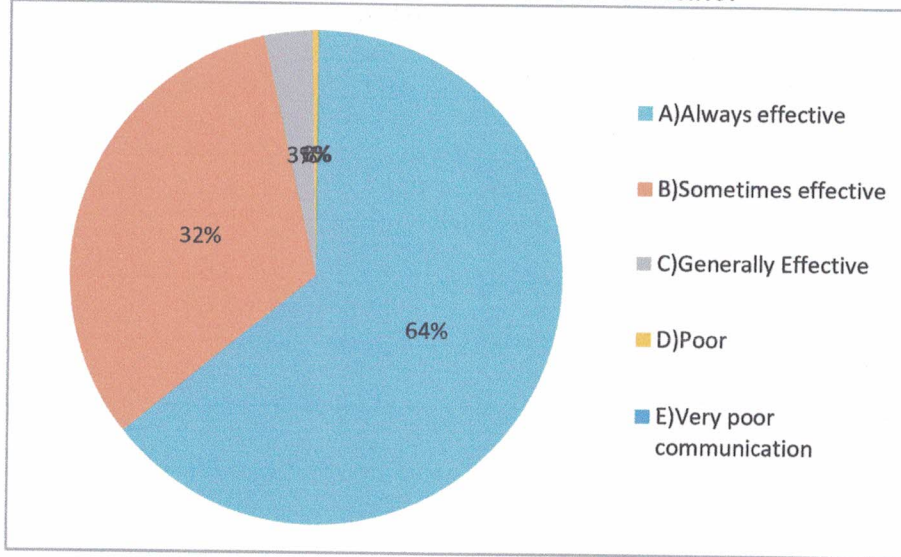
Question No. 7. How much syllabus was covered in the class?



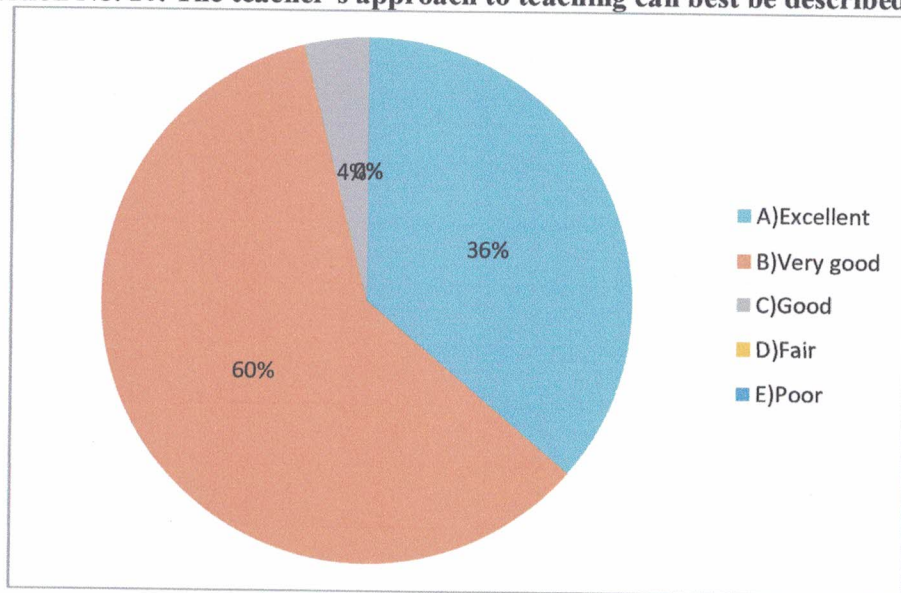
Question No. 8. How does the teachers prepare for the classes?



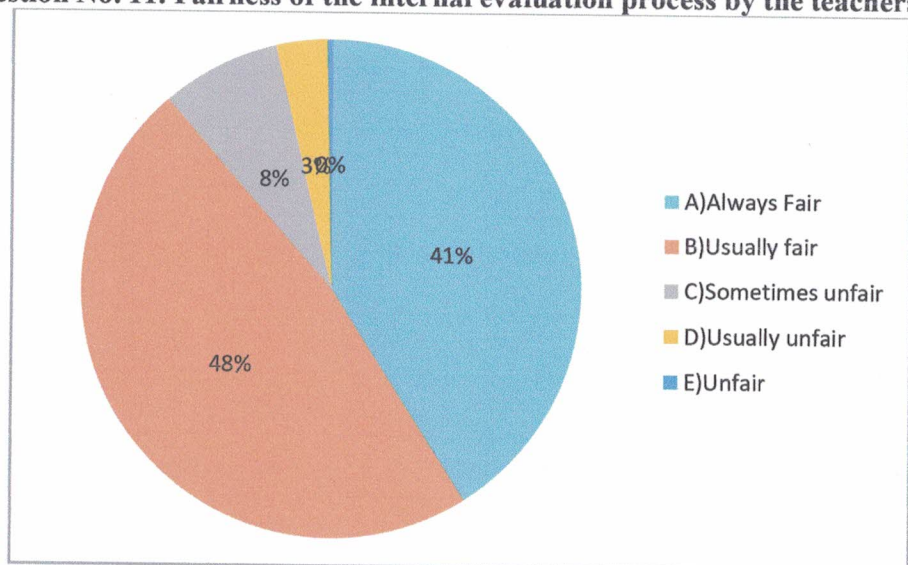
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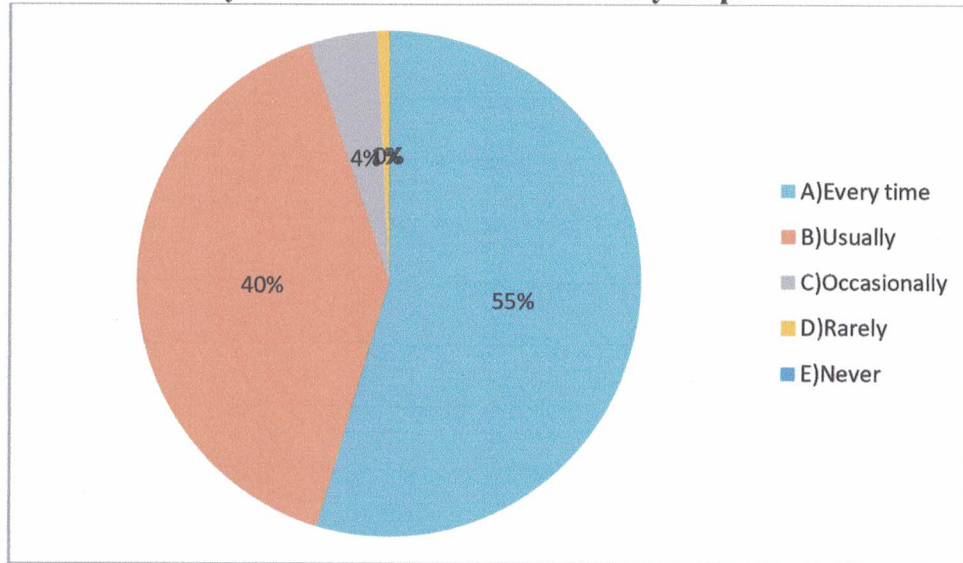
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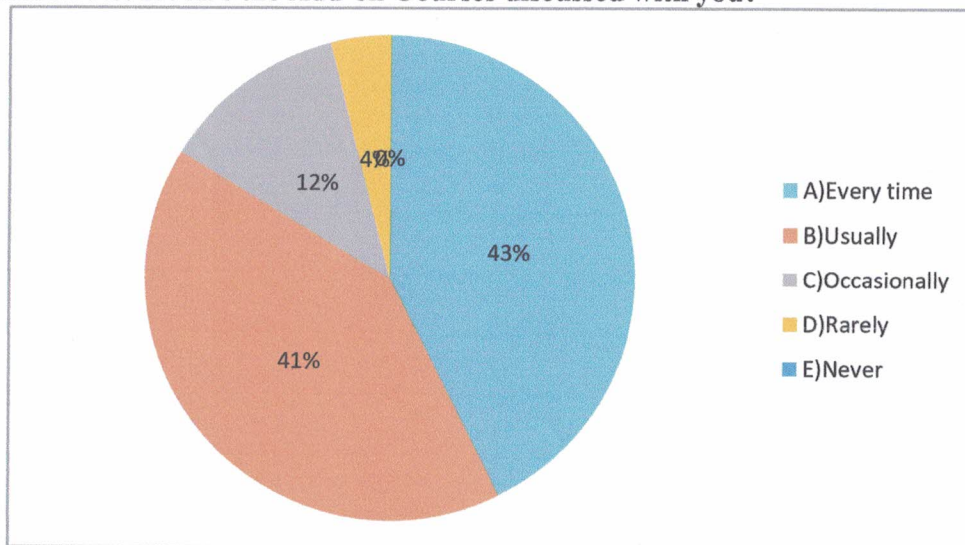
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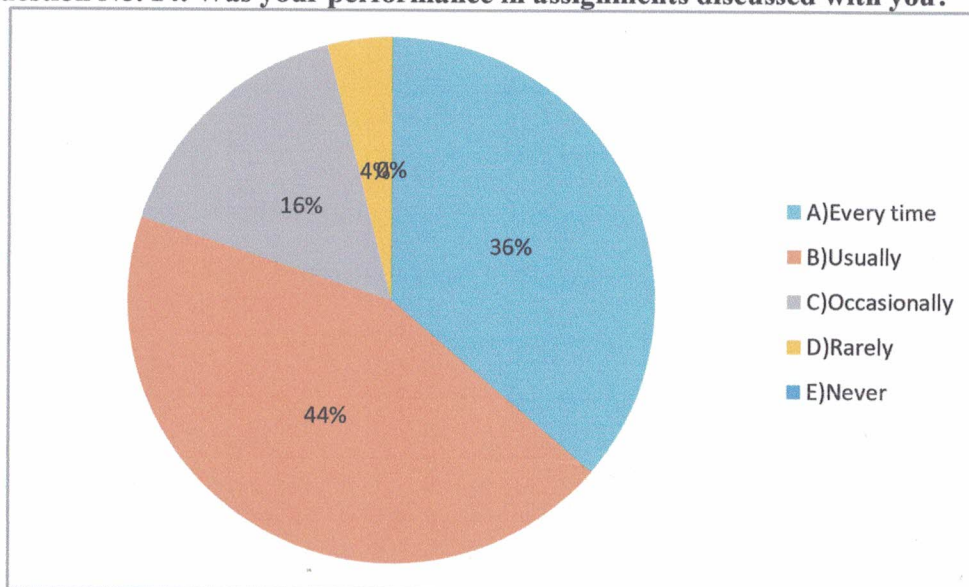
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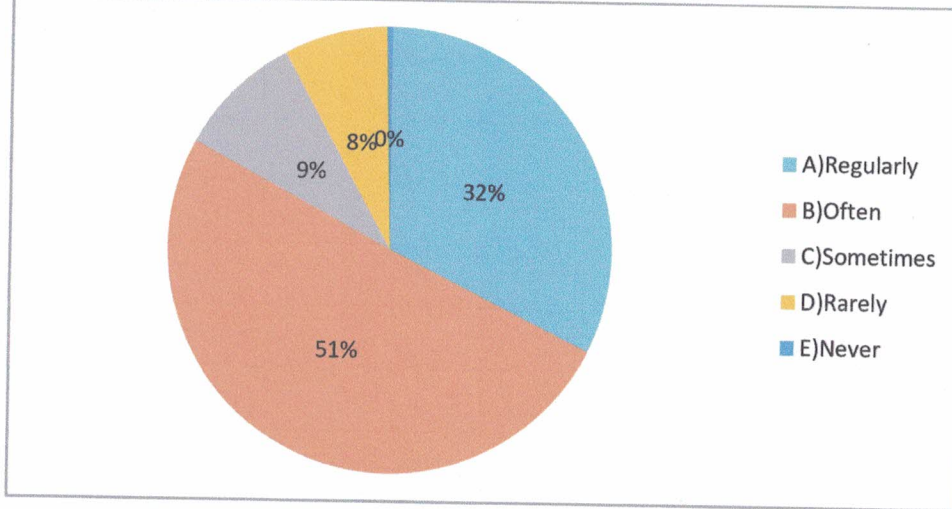
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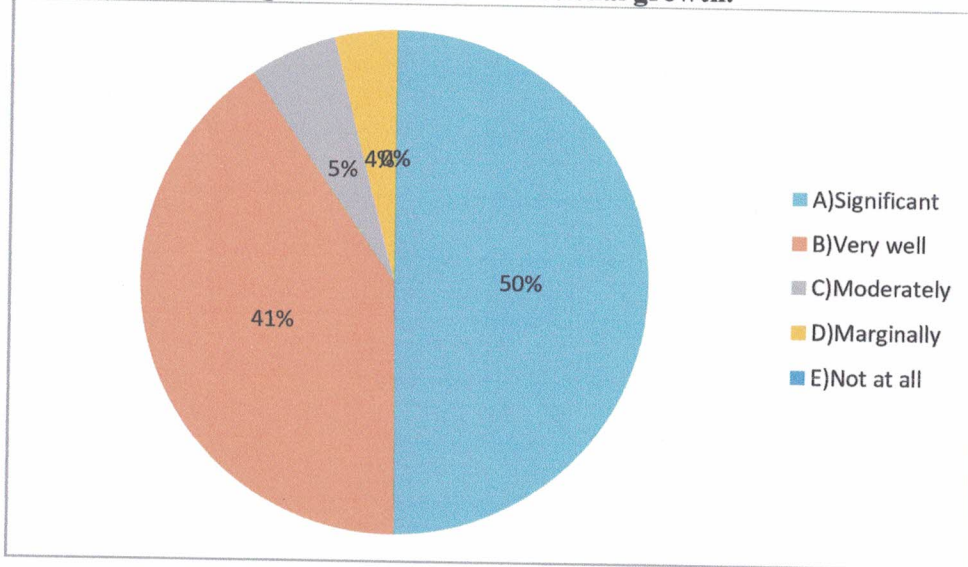
